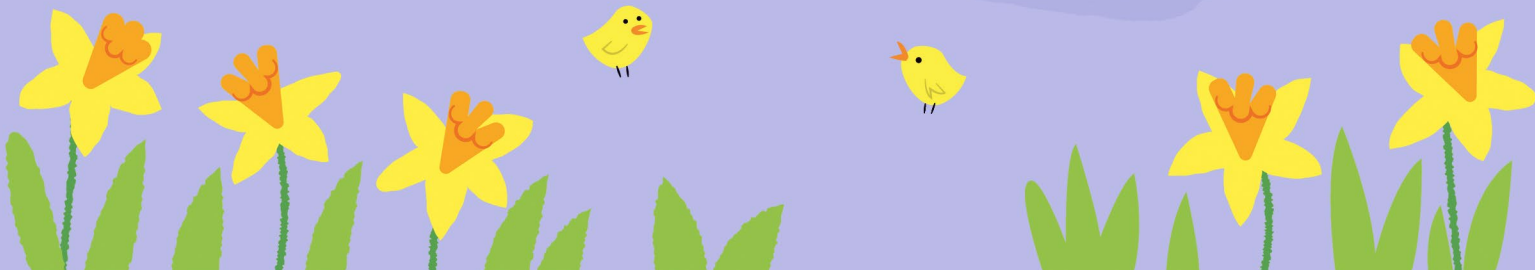

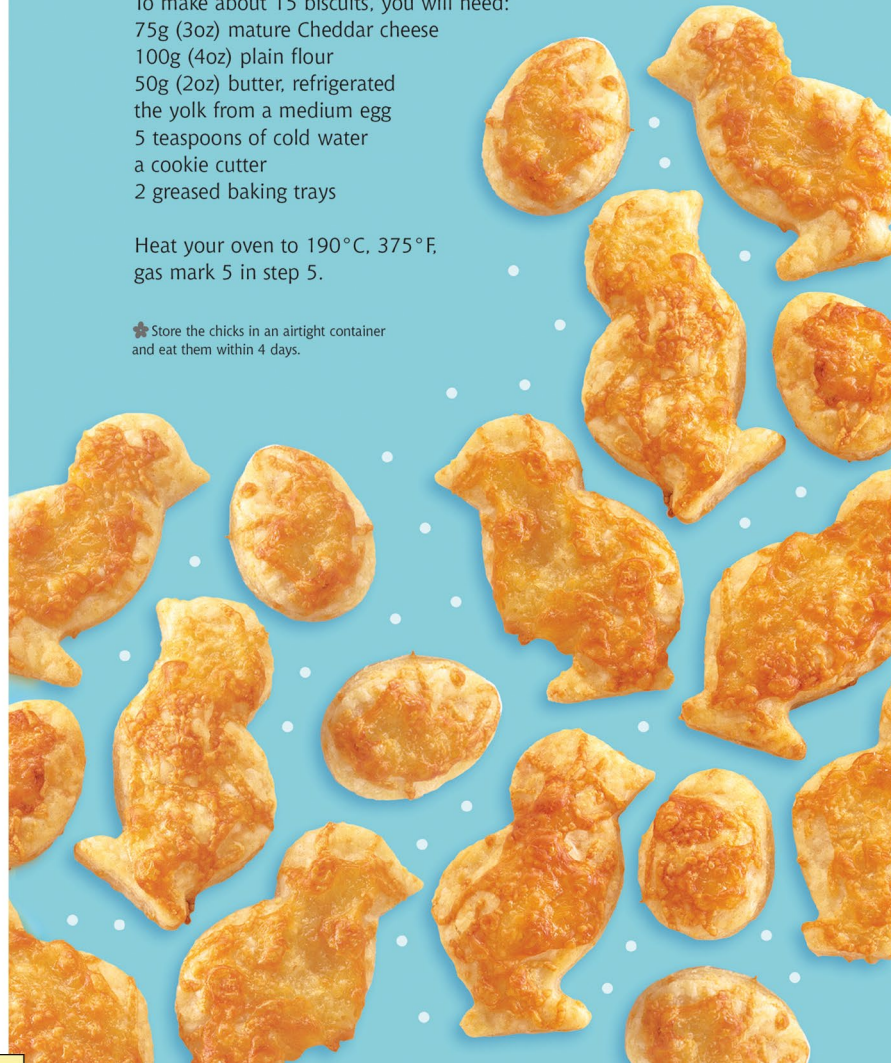
# Cheesy chick biscuits

To make about 15 biscuits, you will need:

- 75g (3oz) mature Cheddar cheese
- 100g (4oz) plain flour
- 50g (2oz) butter, refrigerated
- the yolk from a medium egg
- 5 teaspoons of cold water
- a cookie cutter
- 2 greased baking trays

Heat your oven to 190°C, 375°F, gas mark 5 in step 5.

✦ Store the chicks in an airtight container and eat them within 4 days.



Use the small holes on a grater.



1. Grate the cheese. Sift the flour through a sieve into a large bowl. Then, cut the butter into chunks and add it to the bowl.



2. Mix in the butter, then rub it in with your fingers, until the mixture looks like breadcrumbs. Add half of the cheese.

3. Mix the egg yolk and water in a small bowl. Put 2 teaspoonfuls into a cup, then pour the rest over the flour mixture.



4. Stir everything well. Squeeze the mixture until you have made a smooth dough, then make it into a slightly flattened ball.



5. Wrap the dough in plastic foodwrap and put it into a fridge to chill for 30 minutes. While it chills, turn on your oven.



6. Sprinkle flour onto a clean work surface and a rolling pin. Then, roll out the dough, until it is about 5mm (1/4in) thick.



Leave spaces between the shapes.



Use the mixture from step 3.

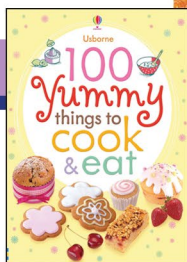
7. Cut out shapes with the cookie cutters. Put them onto the baking trays. Squeeze the scraps into a ball, then roll them out.

8. Cut out more shapes. Brush egg mixture over the top of each shape, then sprinkle them with grated cheese.



Use a spatula.

9. Bake the biscuits for 12 minutes. Leave them on the baking trays for 5 minutes, then lift them onto a wire rack to cool.

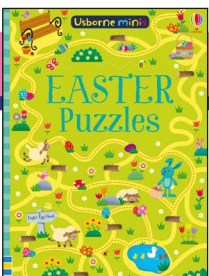

# Make a bunny hat

...to wear to an Easter party.

- 1 Cut a strip of thick white paper that fits around your head.



- 2 Draw on a face like this.



- 3 Cut a slit going down near one end...



- 4 ...and a slit going up near the other end.



- 5 Bend it around and slot the slits together.



- 6 Fold white paper in half.



- 7 Cut it like this to make ears.



- 8 Draw a pink patch on each one.



- 9 Fold the bottom edges together and glue.



- 10 Stick the ears onto the hat.

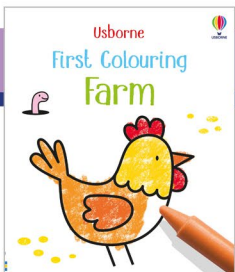

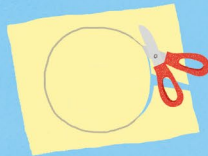
# Make paper birds

These fluttery birds make lovely springtime decorations.

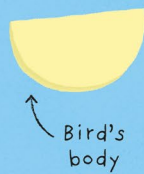
- 1** Draw around a bowl on paper.



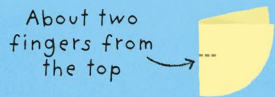
- 2** Cut out the circle...



- 3** ...and fold it in half.



- 4** Fold gently in half and cut like this.



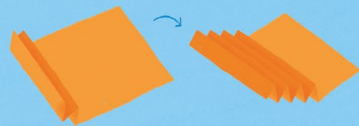
- 5** Unfold and draw an eye near one corner.



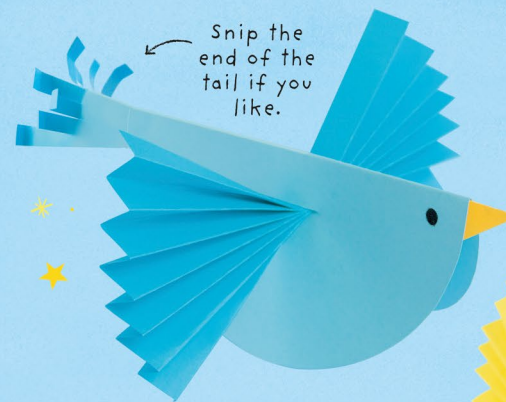
- 6** Fold a piece of paper from the short edge.



- 7** Turn it over and fold it again.



- 8** Keep turning and folding.

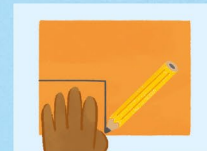


You could add string to hang your bird up.

- 9** Push the folded paper through the slit.



- 10** Draw a rectangle around your fingers on paper.



- 11** Cut it out.



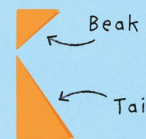
- 12** Fold in half.



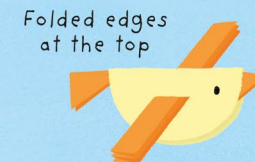
- 13** Draw lines like this.



- 14** Cut along the lines.



- 15** Stick inside the body like this.



- 16** Fan out the wings.

# Chocolate nests

To make 10 chocolate nests, you will need:

225g (8oz) plain chocolate

50g (2oz) butter

2 tablespoons of golden syrup

100g (4oz) corn flakes

30 chocolate mini eggs

paper cake cases

a baking tray with 12 shallow holes

★ Store in an airtight container in a fridge and eat within 3 days.



1. Put 10 paper cases into the holes in the baking tray. Then, break up the chocolate and put it into a large saucepan.



The syrup will slide off the hot spoon.

2. Cut up the butter and add it to the pan. Then, dip a tablespoon into hot water and use it to add the golden syrup.

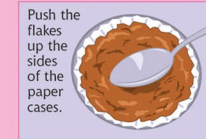


3. Gently heat the pan on a low heat, until the butter and chocolate have melted. Stir the mixture all the time.



Try not to crush the corn flakes.

4. Turn off the heat, then add the corn flakes to the pan. Gently stir them into the chocolate, until they are coated all over.

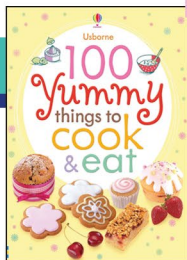


Push the flakes up the sides of the paper cases.

5. Using a teaspoon, fill the paper cases with the chocolate mixture. Make a hollow in the middle of each nest with the spoon.



6. Put three mini eggs into each nest. Then, put the nests into a fridge and leave them for about an hour to harden.
